A Warm Welcome to Worship

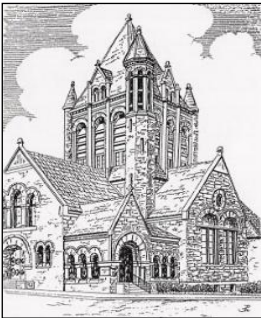
