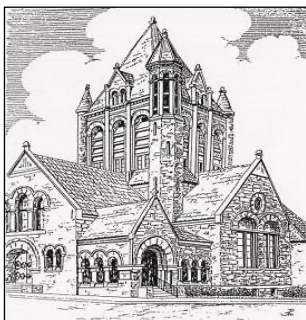
Joyfully we share responsibility of loving, serving and giving to make Jesus Christ known and throughout our community and the world.
