God loves you

As a believer in Jesus, you are, and have already been, and will continue to be alive in Christ!

⁴ Because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, ⁵ made us alive with Christ...⁸ For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God... - Ephesians 2:4, 5, 8

God is all about guarantees - God loves them, he calls them "covenants", and God always holds-up his end of the covenant every time. They are a spiritually binding agreement we have with God.

Our Covenant with God: God promised to love us always and for that love to never end.

No matter how much we think we messed up or do not deserve it, God disagrees --- his love is forever, no matter what we think or feel about it. When God told you, "I love you", that does not ever stop, that promise from God is for keeps. God does not go out of his way to draw you to himself and then cast you adrift ...God always feels the same way about you: "I love you, period".

God does not think about you in negative ways

¹⁶ For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. - John 3:16, 17

We often think and say negative things about ourselves, but God does NOT do that. He always sees you as a Child of God. He rejoices in having made you and rejoices in spending time with you forever.

Notice in v. 16, God makes it clear that he loves you.

Notice in v. 17, God assures you that he is not interested in leveling guilt and placing condemnation on you.

¹⁹ God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. - II Corinthians 5:19

God does NOT count our sins against us. God does not count-them-up and make a long list of them up there in heaven. God is all about removing those sins and obliterating any trace of them by forgiveness for all eternity.

God thinks of you this way: "How can I prepare the way for my child to be forgiven, and forgiven as soon as possible?"
