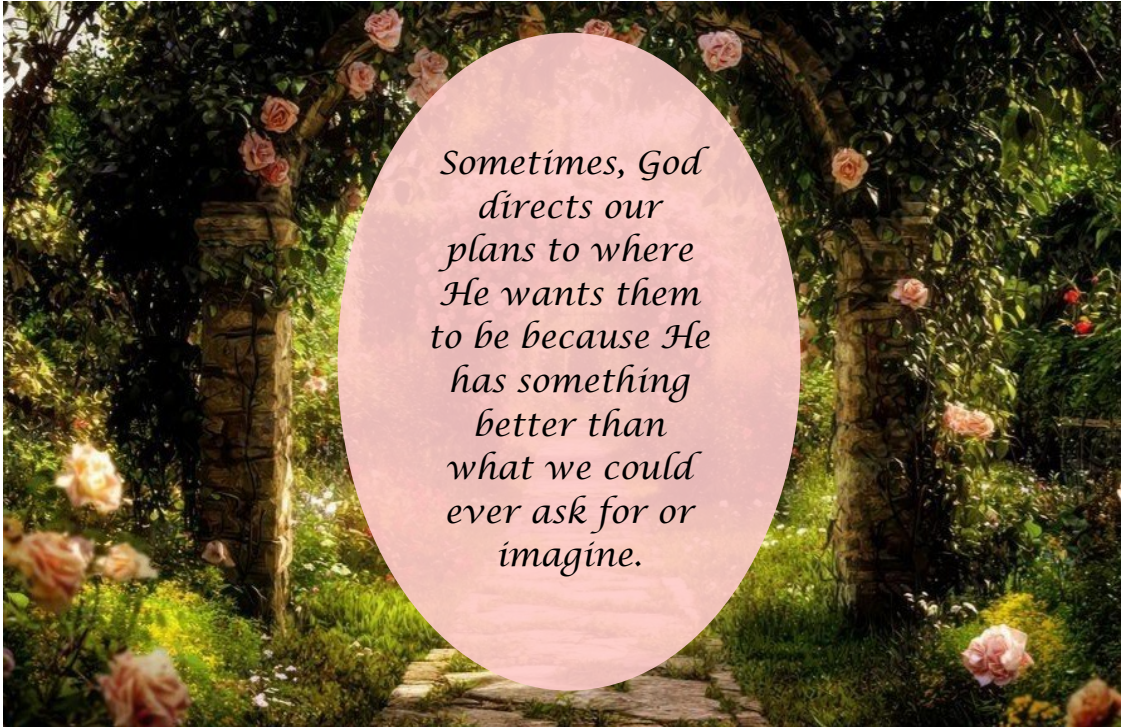

## **A Warm Welcome to Worship**

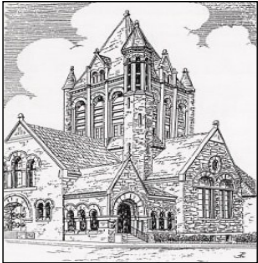
